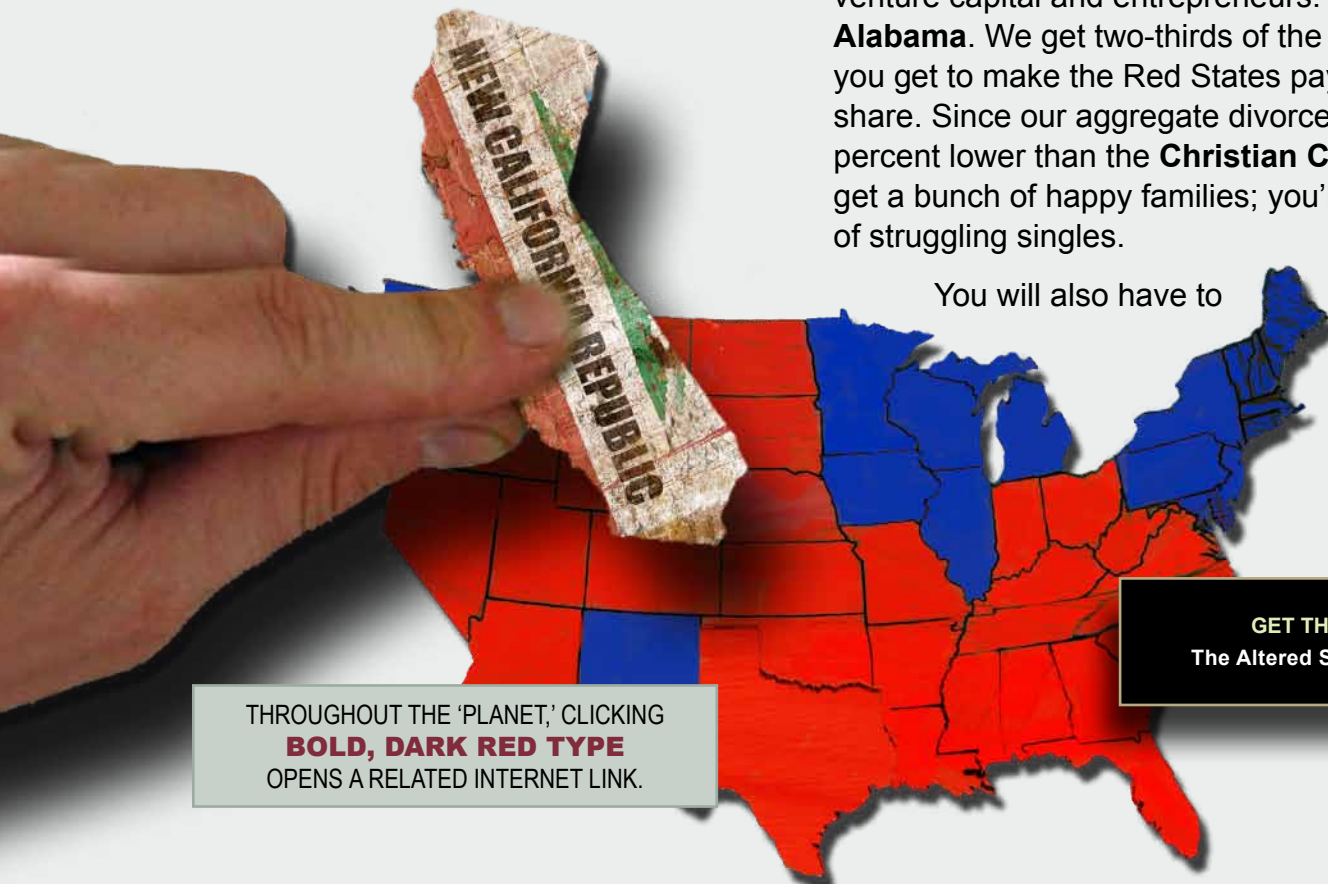

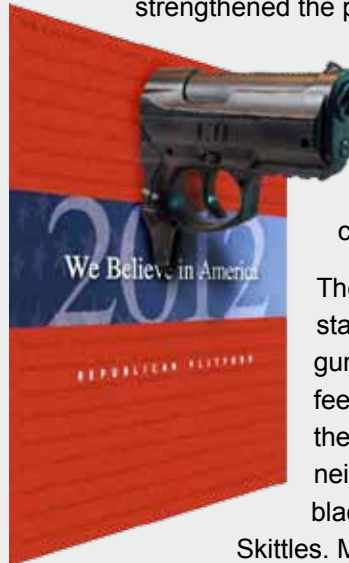

THE BOOK OF MORON?

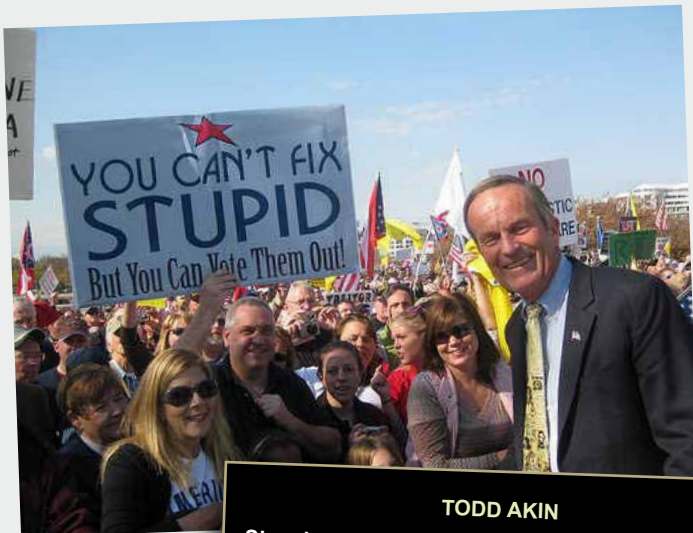

"This version of *Snow White* would give children insomnia and cause them

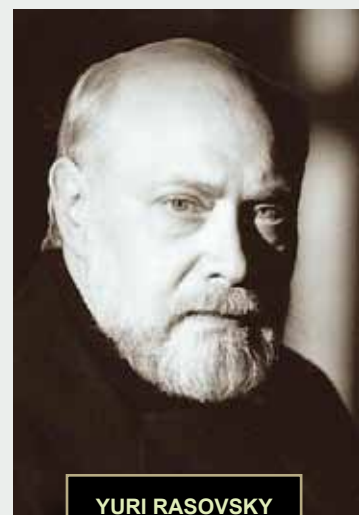
