## The inside 'Dope'

HE FIRESIGN THEATRE AND STAND UP!
Records are soon to present a new double-LP compilation, including 83 minutes of previously uncollected funny bits from the group's notorious "Dear Friends" Radio Show from 1970 to 1972 – a freewheeling demolition derby of surreal comedy seen through the subversive lens of Nixon-era Los Angeles freeform radio.

The record will be Firesign's first new vinyl release in 35 years, since *Eat or Be Eaten* in 1985 and contains 34

tracks spread over four record sides, lovingly produced by our longtime collaborator and archivist, **Taylor Jessen**.

Furthermore, the download

version of the record is greatly expanded and includes 46 tracks totaling two hours 23 minutes. Customers who buy the download directly from Stand Up! Records will also get a 56-page PDF which includes scans of scripts used in the original radio broadcasts.



## Bear with me

hikers in Glacier National Park and other Rocky
Mountain parks to be alert for bears and take extra
precautions to avoid an encounter.

They advise park visitors to wear little bells on their clothes so they make noise when hiking. The bell noise allows bears to hear them coming from a distance and not be startled by a hiker accidentally sneaking up on them, which might cause the bear to charge.

Visitors should also carry a pepper spray can just in case a bear is encountered. Spraying the pepper into the air will irritate the bear's sensitive nose and it will run away.

It is also a good idea to keep an eye out for fresh bear scat, so you have an idea if bears are in the area. People should be able to recognize the difference between black bear and grizzly bear scat. Black bear droppings are smaller and often contain berries, leaves, and possibly bits of fur. Grizzly bear droppings tend to contain small bells and smell of pepper.


